SUBJECT: Proposed Resolution - State and Community Highway Safety Program Grant

The Florida Department of Transportation is offering a State and Community Highway Safety Program Grant. The \$66,670, grant funding will provide the following Laser/Radar Units; 5-Laser LZ-2, 15 Radar SD2-Ka, and 1-Speed Commander Alert Trailer. This speed enforcement equipment, acquired through grant funding, will enable the COPS Unit through the Road Patrol Division to combat the overwhelming traffic problems in Davie. This is a reimbursement type grant and therefore, will not require a match or local share.

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, TOWN ADMINISTRATOR AND APPROPRIATE STAFF TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING UNDER THE STATE AND COMMUNITY HIGHWAY SAFETY PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the The Florida Department of Transportation administers the State and Community Highway Safety Program, and

WHEREAS, funding is available under The Florida Department of Transportation providing \$66,670 in grant funding for five Laser LZ-2, fifteen radar SD2Ka and one Speed Commander Alert Trailer; and

WHEREAS, the State and Community Highway Safety Program grant funding will result in speed enforcement equipment to help combat the overwhelming traffic problems in the Town ; and

WHEREAS, this is a reimbursement grant and there is no local cost share or match requirement by the State and Community Highway Safety Program administered by The Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Town of Davie that the Police Department apply for and secure grant funding under the State and Community Highway Safety Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the Town Council authorizes the Mayor, Town Administrator and/or appropriate staff to submit an application for grant funding under the State and Community Highway Safety Program.

SECTION 2. The Town Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and/or appropriate staff to accept the grant if awarded.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
