**TITLE OF AGENDA ITEM:** A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A LETTER SUPPORTING THE DISTRIBUTION OF FEDERAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE FUNDS IN BROWARD COUNTY

**REPORT IN BRIEF:** The Broward County Commission on Substance Abuse is coordinating the community's application for over one million dollars in Federal Anti-Drug Abuse funds. All Broward County municipalities were notified of the available funding and have been advised that bringing the intended programs into our communities will benefit the whole of Broward County. A letter of approval from the municipal Mayors in Broward County is requested to receive and distribute this funding of \$1,155,885. The Broward County Commission on Substance Abuse will distribute funding to the Broward County municipalities, according to the attached list of 24 programs funded. The Town of Davie has received funding over the past four years for the A.D.A.P.T. program but we were ineligible to apply this year and will not be receiving any of these funds. We are supporting this funding source, which enables the development and maintenance for drug prevention and treatment programs is important, not only to the Davie community, but county wide.

WHEREAS, the Broward County Commission on Substance Abuse is coordinating the community's application for over one million dollars in Federal Anti-Drug Abuse funds for the Fiscal Year 2001; and

WHEREAS, many letters of intent have been submitted by numerous municipalities on various grant projects; and

WHEREAS, in order for Broward County to receive these funds fifty-one percent of the support of the Mayors of all the municipalities and execute a letter supporting the distribution of \$1,155,885, Anti-Drug Abuse funds for projects within Broward County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Davie hereby supports the countywide distribution of Anti-Drug Abuse funds and authorizes the Mayor to execute a letter indicating his support.

Once signed, please have a copy sent back to me for my file.



Dear Mayor Venis:

As you know, the Broward County Commission on Substance Abuse is coordinating the community's application for over one million dollars in Federal Anti-Drug Abuse funds for fiscal 2000.

After notifying all municipalities, their police chiefs, treatment providers and others in the community of the funds available, we received 36 letters of intent for projects. Cities, law enforcement, treatment providers and criminal justice agencies are represented in the proposals. A list of the applicants is attached.

It is important to note that although we will be unable to fund all 36 projects, bringing these programs into our communities benefits the whole of Broward County and in order for the county and cities to receive these funds, **the Mayor must sign a letter approving the funding of the selected projects. The enclosed sample letter must be typed on your city stationery and signed by the Mayor.**
