WHEREAS, fire drills should be practiced regularly, at least twice a year; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Davie Fire Rescue Department is dedicated to the safety of life and property from the devastating effects of fire and medical emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the members of the fire service are joined by other concerned citizens of Davie, as well as businesses, schools, service clubs and organizations in their fire safety efforts; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Mayor and Town Council proclaim the week of October 7-13, 2001 as;

FIRE PREVENTION WEEK

This week commemorates the great Chicago fire of October 9, 1871, which killed more than 250 persons, left 100,000 homeless and destroyed more than 17,400 buildings.

We call upon the people of the Town of Davie to participate in fire prevention activities at home, work and school and to heed the message: “**Cover Your Bases & Strike Out Fire**” to ensure their safety and the safety of their families in the event of a fire.
