A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE BID AWARDED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, BID NO. 20-148T FOR SUPPLYING RUNNING TRACK SURFACING AND STRIPING FOR NOVA HIGH SCHOOL.

REPORT IN BRIEF:

The Town is in need of running track surfacing for Nova High School. A suitable product manufactured by Southwest Recreational Industries, Inc. (SRI) may be purchased under a School Board of Broward County contract. The School Board contract may be found on the School Board's web site, <http://www.browardschools.com> It is listed under "Athletic Track Surfacing and Striping". The School Board of Broward County is currently installing the same track surfacing system under this contract at Cooper City High School, South Plantation High School and at Piper High School.

The track is 3,508 square yards. The Eurotan "ME" system that we are purchasing is \$25.28 per square yard, totaling \$88,682.24, which will be reimbursed by the School Board of Broward County.

PREVIOUS ACTIONS: Reciprocal Lease Agreement between Town of Davie and School Board of Broward County which has two phases, whereas the School Board agrees to reimburse the Town for construction expenses. (Resolutions R-2002-175 and R-2003-45)

REQUESTED ACTION:
It is requested that The School Board of Broward County, Florida, approve renewal of the contract with Southwest Recreational Industries, Inc. for an additional two-year period through November 2, 2004, in accordance with Special Condition 1.01 of Bid No. 20-148T, Athletic Track Surfacing and Striping; and authorize additional expenditures up to \$450,000.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:
Contractor: Southwest Recreational Industries, Inc.

The contract was originally awarded November 2, 1999, for Bid No. 20-148T, Athletic Track Surfacing and Striping, has been utilized for the installation of synthetic rubber polyurethane-bound sports surface coating of running track and field event paved areas at Coral Springs High and Fort Lauderdale High. The initial contract was for a three-year period and may be renewed for two additional one-year periods. Southwest Recreational Industries, Inc. has agreed to renew the contract at the same pricing, terms and conditions of the Invitation to Bid. This recommendation will provide for the continued procurement of services for athletic track surfacing and striping projects as required through November 2, 2004.

A copy of Bid No. 20-148T Athletic Track Surfacing and Striping is available in the School Board Members Offices.




