

## **1st Quarter Employee Recognition**

Officer Curtis Mancini, father of three, joined the Davie Police Department 16 years ago. He held positions in patrol, street crimes, SWAT, and narcotics. Officer Mancini was a member of the US Drug Enforcement Administration's Southeast Florida Regional Task Force. He was a State of Florida certified and licensed firearms instructor, field training officer, and defensive driving instructor. In addition, Officer Mancini had a total of 19 years of service with the US Army, Florida Army National Guard and US Army Reserve. On January 29, 2004, Officer Curtis Mancini was killed in combat while serving overseas. Officer Curtis Mancini was a highly respected and well liked employee that is greatly missed.

In addition to Officer Curtis Mancini, the following employees are being recognized, Thomas Resko, Gregory Ryan, and Officer Ronald Bradley for their service to the residents of Davie and for serving this Country in the war in Iraq.

Tom Resko has been an employee of the Davie Police Department since February 2001. He was a Police Service Aide assigned to road patrol. Recently, he was promoted to Police Officer Trainee. Tom is married with children and served in the Army during the initial year of war.

Gregory Ryan is a Police Service Aide SA. He has been an employee of the Davie Police Department since January 1999. Gregory is married and is presently serving his country in Iraq where he has been for the past year.

Ronald Bradley is presently assigned to the Detective Bureau. He has been employed with the Davie Police Department since March 1996. Detective Bradley has been assigned to a Military Intelligence Unit operating out of South Florida during the war.
