### Pollworker Recruitment

(Broward County, Florida) – In addition to other sources, the Broward County Supervisor of Elections office is encouraging all cities and their employees to participate in the upcoming elections, including the Primary Election, scheduled for August 26, 2008 and the General Election, November 4, 2008 Countywide. Residents and city employees are needed to serve as Voting System Technicians (VSTs) and as Clerks at polling locations throughout the County. Voters who are bi-lingual (English/Spanish and English/Creole) are especially needed for all assignments at the polls.

Training will be provided by the Supervisor of Elections and payment for service is listed below:

- Voting System Technician (VST) \$200
  - Field Voting System Technician \$200, plus mileage
  - Clerk \$200
  - Super Clerk \$220
  - Assistant Clerk \$155
  - Special Deputy \$160
  - Inspector \$150
  - Electronic Voter Identification (EVID) System Operator \$150 (Data Entry skills)
  - Bilingual individuals will be paid according to the position filled.
