



Existing Condition - Orange Drive

Like most of the streets within the study area, Orange Drive is poorly spatially defined. Buildings are low and set too far from the street. The C-11 Canal runs along the south side of the street making enclosure difficult to accomplish with buildings.



Proposed Condition - Orange Drive

Where street enclosure can not be provided by buildings, tall shade trees can overcome the problem. Orange Drive should be designed with wide sidewalks and pedestrian scaled lighting throughout the study area and west to downtown Davie.



A consistent, closely planted alignment of large shade trees has the power to enclose the space of a small street. Plantings of live oaks could transform Orange Drive into a very beautiful and memorable street.
