Coaches Background Checks

All persons interested in volunteering in the Town of Davie Sports programs must follow the following process to be considered. This includes coaches and assistant coaches.

1. Please contact Jeanette Reddy or Tina Smelser at 954-797-1145 to set up an appointment. A volunteer application and copy of drivers license will be required.
2. You will need to have a Live Scan fingerprinting completed prior to the start of the season you wish to volunteer for. If you have any questions, please contact the Sports Coordinator at 954-327-3944.
3. Head coaches that have at least one child registered, and coached the whole season will be issued a refund minus the cost of the uniform for that child upon return of the equipment bag.
