TITLE OF AGENDA ITEM: A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE BID FOR RESURFACING HOCKEY RINKS AT BAMFORD SPORTS COMPLEX.

REPORT IN BRIEF: A competitive bid was conducted for resurfacing of three (3) roller hockey rinks at Bamford Sports Complex. The Town sent out specifications to eleven (11) prospective bidders. Additionally, the bid was advertised state-wide in Florida Bid Reporting and nationally in BidNet and also posted on the Town's web site. The Town received two (2) bids. The original application was performed by Pro Courts. The manufacturer represents that the product provides a trouble-free surface for at least three (3) years. However, three of the four rinks have surfaces that are peeling a little over a year later. Therefore, it is the opinion of the Capital Projects Department that Pro Courts did not do a very good job the first time around (see department memo for more details). Therefore, the recommendation is for Florida Courtworks whose bid is still within budget and is a contractor that the Town has successfully worked with in the past.

Upon examining the two bids received on Tuesday, December 3, 2002 at about 2:00 p.m., it is my recommendation to award this contract to the second low bidder, **Florida Courtworks** for \$28,350.00. Although there was a lower bid, from Pro Courts for \$22,890.00, we are not recommending that the award be made to the low bidder.

Mr. Jim Reynolds of Pro Courts was the contractor that originally surfaced the four roller hockey rinks at Pine Island Park. Just over a year later, three of them now need to be resurfaced due to peeling. The Plexiflor system, manufactured by "California Products Corporation" which was specified to be installed on these rinks should have lasted for many years as a trouble-free surface. We do not feel that we should award the resurfacing to the same vendor since the first application did not meet our expectations and wear life after his initial installation.

The second low bid was also below our estimate and we feel that it is a fair price. We have worked with Florida Courtworks previously on other projects and have had no problems to date with their work.
