WHEREAS, the South Florida Trail Riders of Broward County continues to promote, protect and develop safe equestrian trails throughout the Town of Davie, Broward County and the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, this year is the 25th Anniversary of the South Florida Trail Riders of Broward County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Davie, hereby proclaim September 12th, 2004 as;
