

WHEREAS, Bob Amchir, President of Wings of Gold Motorcycle Club organized a big toy drive netting \$965 cash and over 500 toys with about 700 motorcycles participating the first year; and

WHEREAS, since the 1st Toy Run, 16 years ago bikers and supporters have raised in excess of \$4,000,000 which is used for cancer treatments and other special needs for kids; and

WHEREAS, in 2003 the Annual Christmas Toys in the Sun Run raised over \$481,000 and over 40,000 toys were collected and distributed to local needy children in the tri-county area by The Fraternal Order of Police, District #5.

WHEREAS, proceeds benefit the Joe DeMaggio Children's Hospital, Hollywood, Florida and the Boys & Girls Clubs of Broward County. In addition, funds and toys were given to the Area Agency on Aging, Boys & Girls Clubs, Davie Kiwanis, EASE Foundation, Hope Outreach, Cystic Fibrosis, Juvenile Diabetes, Cancer, Prenatal Care and much more; and

WHEREAS, Bob Amchir, President of the SFPC and Chief Director of the Toy Run with his Son, David takes on the responsibility of putting together this year's event expecting to make almost \$500,000 and collect 50,000 toys; and

WHEREAS, on Sunday, December 5, 2004 more than 30,000 motorcyclists are expected To take part in the 17th Annual SFPC Christmas Toys in the Sun Run presented by Rick Case Honda; and

WHEREAS, Sherriff Ken Jenne will be coordinating Broward County, 22 police departments and 230 officers closing down three interstate highways and traveling through Davie to Markham Park.
