**TITLE OF AGENDA ITEM:** A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR A \$500,000 DISCRETIONARY GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, INTERMODAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, FOR THE OAKES ROAD INTERMODAL BRIDGE AND STATIONS STUDY; AND AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE AND EXECUTION OF THE GRANT, IF AWARDED.

**REPORT IN BRIEF:** The SR 7/US 441 Corridor Master Plan, which was adopted by the Town of Davie in September 2005, provides a long term vision for the current industrial - commercial area of the Town that is bound by the Turnpike on the west and SR 7 on the east. The plan includes a recommendation for improved mobility and traffic circulation by extending the existing Oakes Road over the Florida Turnpike via a new bridge. Such a bridge is expected to link the area with the Regional Activity Center, to increase transit usage, and to decrease the number of vehicles that must currently utilize the SR 84/I-595 or the Griffin Road corridors for local trips. The Town has coordinated with the South Florida Regional Planning Council on a grant application to the Florida Department of Transportation to conduct a feasibility study for the recommended bridge. The Town has requested \$500,000 from FDOT for the study and initial design. No matching funds from the Town are required.

**PREVIOUS ACTIONS:** With R-2005-236, the Town Council approved the State Road 7 / U.S. 441 Corridor Master Plan Document.

RESOLUTION R-2006-\_\_\_\_\_

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR A \$500,000 DISCRETIONARY GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, INTERMODAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, FOR THE OAKES ROAD INTERMODAL BRIDGE AND STATIONS STUDY; AND AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE AND EXECUTION OF THE GRANT, IF AWARDED.

WHEREAS, with Resolution 2005-236 the Town of Davie adopted the State Road 7/U.S. 441 Master Plan Document, which provides a long-term vision for the Town's current industrial and commercial area, generally bordered by State Road 7 and the Florida Turnpike; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Davie wishes to explore the feasibility of the Plan's recommendation for improved transit mobility and circulation via a new bridge over the Florida Turnpike; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Davie will apply for a discretionary grant from the Florida Department of Transportation to conduct a feasibility and design study for the Oakes Road intermodal bridge and stations, as recommended in the State Road 7 / U.S. 441 Master Plan Document.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA.

SECTION 1. The Town Council of the Town of Davie hereby authorizes the Acting Town Administrator and/or Development Services Director to submit a grant application to the Florida Department of Transportation, Intermodal Development Program, requesting \$500,000 in grant funds to conduct a feasibility and design study for the Oakes Road intermodal bridge and stations.

SECTION 2. The Town Council authorizes the Acting Town Administrator and/or Development Services Director to accept and implement the grant, if awarded, and to execute all necessary grant contracts, documents, progress reports, invoices and extension requests.

SECTION 3. The Town Council authorizes the Director of Budget and Finance to recognize grant revenue, if awarded the grant, and to appropriate the funds into the appropriate departmental budget.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
