TITLE OF AGENDA ITEM: A Resolution of the Town of Davie, Florida, requesting Broward County install a pedestrian traffic signal in the 3000 Block of Nob Hill Road.

REPORT IN BRIEF: The Town's primary East/West trail corridor traverses Nob Hill Road and does not currently afford the protection of a pedestrian crossing signal. The attached Resolution identifies the need for this installation and requests approval and installation by Broward County.

PREVIOUS ACTIONS: The Town has previously with Broward County outlining the need for this signal however, these efforts have been unsuccessful to date.

RESOLUTION _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA, REQUESTING BROWARD COUNTY INSTALL A PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC SIGNAL IN THE 3000 BLOCK OF NOB HILL ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Town of Davie, has developed a multi-purpose trail corridor which traverses the Town from East to West linking parks and open space preserves providing access and trail experiences for residents throughout the Town; and

WHEREAS, this East/West trail corridor necessitates a crossing of Nob Hill Road, a multilane, major arterial highway; and

WHEREAS, high traffic volumes and vehicle travel speeds create a hazardous crossing condition for pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians attempting to cross Nob Hill Road without benefit of a traffic safety signal; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Davie recognizes this hazardous condition and supports the installation of a pedestrian traffic signal device.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA.

SECTION 1. The Town Council of the Town of Davie, hereby petitions Broward County to install a pedestrian traffic signal in the 3000 Block of South Nob Hill Road for the protection of pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians crossing Nob Hill Road.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
