REPORT IN BRIEF: The events of September 11, 2001, have changed our country tremendously. In consideration of this, Town of Davie Councilwoman Susan Starkey and Chiefs of Fire Rescue and Police have proposed a Memorial to recognize the Town's fallen Public Safety heroes. In developing this Memorial, a partnership including the Town of Davie (consisting of the Mayor and Council, Town Administration, Chiefs of the Fire Rescue and Police Department, and Town Staff) and the Davie Police and Fire Rescue fraternal organizations will be established to participate in the planning and development of a Public Safety Memorial. This Public Safety Memorial will provide for the education of our children and adult residents of the community and serve as a ceremonial site for the community to reflect on tragic events. The source of funding for this Memorial will be through solicitations for private donations and private sponsorships conducted by the partners in this Memorial project. The contribution that the Town of Davie will make in this partnership is to host this Memorial by providing an elective site (to be determined), provide for direction by Council to authorize the Town Administrator to direct staff to assist in developing the Memorial, and commitment by the Town to maintain this Memorial in future years.
