FORT LAUDERDALE -- Construction and maintenance-related lane closures on state highways in Broward County are expected during the week of June 10 through June 17. INTERSTATE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

1. I-95 from the Golden Glades Interchange in Miami-Dade County to Broward Boulevard in Broward County

Traffic Impact:

- Up to three southbound lanes of I-95 from Sunrise Boulevard in Broward County to the Golden Glades Interchange in Miami-Dade County will be closed as needed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. At least two lanes will remain open at all times. Entrance and exit ramps will be closed as needed in the work zone. Detours will be clearly marked and electronic signs will advise drivers in advance.
- Up to three northbound lanes of I-95 from the Golden Glades Interchange in Miami-Dade County to Sunrise Boulevard in Broward County will be closed as needed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Entrance and exit ramps will be closed as needed in the work zone. Detours will be clearly marked and electronic signs will advise drivers in advance.
- Northbound and southbound express lanes will be closed as needed Sunday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. for plastic pole replacement. Driver should use the non-tolled general use lanes.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll Express lanes from northern Miami-Dade County north 13 miles to Fort Lauderdale. The project includes installing Intelligent Transportation System components; modifying the Ives Dairy Road interchange;

Cost/Completion: The construction cost is \$120 million. Completion is expected spring 2016.

2. I-95 from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- The northbound inside lane of I-95 from Davie Road to Commercial Boulevard will be closed Sunday, June 19 through Thursday, June 23 and Sunday, June 26 through Thursday, June 30 between 10:30 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Broward County. High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes are being converted to two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment; widening bridges; and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 Southbound between Broward Boulevard and NW 6th Street, and along I-95 Northbound between Powerline Road and Commercial Boulevard. Contract time began Monday, October 4, 2015, with design activities currently underway. Construction is anticipated to begin in summer 2016. Cost/Completion: The construction cost is \$149 million. Completion is expected in fall 2019.

3. I-95 from north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale to south of SW 10th Street in Deerfield Beach

Traffic Impact:

- The southbound inside lane of I-95 from north of Cypress Creek Road to Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed Tuesday, June 14 through Friday, June 17 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- The southbound inside lane of I-95 from north of Sample Road to Copans Road will be closed Tuesday, June 21 through Friday, June 24 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard to south of SW 10th Street in Broward County. High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes are being converted to two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment; widening bridges; and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 northbound between Atlantic Boulevard and Sample Road, and along I-95 southbound north of Sample Road. Contract time for this \$154 million project began **Friday, January 8, 2016**, with design activities currently underway. Construction is anticipated to begin in Fall 2016. Cost/Completion: The construction cost is \$154 million. Completion is expected in winter 2019.

4. I-95 Interchange from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10th Street

Traffic Impact:

- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street will be fully closed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists can detour via Hillsboro Boulevard.
- The outside lanes of I-95 southbound between Hillsboro Boulevard and SW 10th Street will be closed Sunday through Friday with the first lane closing at 9 p.m., the second lane closing at 10 p.m. and the third lane, if necessary, closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m.
- Two westbound lanes of SW 10th Street at I-95 will be closed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- The sidewalk on the north side of SW 10th Street between SW 12th Avenue and SW Natura Boulevard is closed through August 2016. Signs are in place to direct pedestrians to the south sidewalk.

Description: This project consists of widening southbound I-95 to add an auxiliary lane from the Hillsboro Boulevard entrance ramp to the SW 10th Street exit ramp, widening the existing southbound I-95 exit ramp to SW 10th Street, addition of a free flow right turn lane to westbound SW 10th Street, widening of westbound SW 10th Street to add an acceleration lane, utility relocation, milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, installation of barrier walls, curbs, sidewalks, guardrail, drainage, overhead signs, signing and pavement markings, signals, lighting, and retaining walls. This is the first of five interchange improvement projects throughout Broward and Palm Beach Counties. Cost/Completion: Construction cost for all five projects is \$32.5 million. Completion in summer 2017.

5. I-75 from NW 170th Street in Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County

Traffic Impact:

- **Segment A & B (NW 170th Avenue in Miami-Dade County to South of Miramar Parkway in Broward County)**
 - Two southbound lanes of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - Two northbound lanes of I-75 from south of Florida's Turnpike to Snake Creek Canal will be closed Sunday through Friday between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - Two southbound lanes of I-75 from south of Florida's Turnpike to NW 170th Avenue will be closed Sunday through Friday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - One lane of the ramp from northbound Florida's Turnpike to northbound I-75 will be closed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - One lane of the ramp from southbound I-75 to southbound Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - Two lanes in each direction of Florida's Turnpike at I-75 will be closed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - One northbound lane of I-75 from NW 170th Street to north of Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday through Friday between 6 a.m. and 4 p.m.
 - Two northbound lanes of I-75 from NW 170th Street to Miami Gardens Drive will be closed Sunday through Friday between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.

- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to south of Miramar Parkway will be closed Sunday through Friday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to NW 170th Street will be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- **Segment C (South of Miramar Parkway to South of Sheridan Street)**
 - One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed Monday through Friday between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. for bridge construction.
 - One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. for bridge construction.
 - Two northbound lanes of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to south of Sheridan Street will be closed Sunday through Friday between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. for bridge construction.
 - One southbound lane of I-75 from north of Pines Boulevard to south of Pines Boulevard may be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. for bridge construction.
 - One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Pines Boulevard to north of Pines Boulevard will be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. for bridge construction.
 - One southbound lane of I-75 from north of Pines Boulevard to south of Pines Boulevard may be closed Sunday through Friday between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. for bridge construction.
 - One northbound lane of I-75 from north of Pines Boulevard to south of Pines Boulevard may be closed Sunday through Friday between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. for bridge construction.
 - One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. for bridge construction.
 - One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed Sunday through Friday between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. for bridge construction.
 - One lane of the I-75 southbound exit ramp to Miramar Parkway West (Exit 7B) will be closed Sunday through Friday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. for bridge construction.
 - One lane of the I-75 northbound exit ramp to Miramar Parkway West (Exit 7B) will be closed Sunday through Friday between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. for bridge construction.
 - Two lanes in each direction of Miramar Parkway at I-75 will be closed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. for bridge construction.
 - One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed Sunday through Friday between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m.

- All southbound lanes of I-75 at Miramar Parkway will be closed from 11 p.m. Saturday, June 11 to 5 a.m. Monday, June 13. Motorists will be detoured at Miramar Parkway West (Exit 7B), cross over Miramar Parkway at the top of the ramp and re-enter I-75 southbound using the Miramar Parkway on-ramp. Please follow the posted detour.
- **Segment D (South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road)**
 - One lane in each direction of I-75 from south of Sheridan Street to north of Griffin Road may be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m.
 - One lane in each direction of Sheridan Street at I-75 may be closed Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.
 - Two lanes in either direction of Sheridan Street at I-75 may be closed Sunday through Friday between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
 - Two lanes in either direction of I-75 from south of Sheridan Street to north of Griffin Road may be closed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - The I-75 northbound ramp to Sheridan Street West (Exit 11B) may be closed Sunday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Motorists will be detoured to exit at Sheridan Street East and make a U-turn at Flamingo Road to go west on Sheridan Street. Other alternate routes are Griffin Road and Pines Boulevard.
 - The I-75 southbound ramp to Sheridan Street East (Exit 11A) may be closed Sunday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Motorists will be detoured to exit at Sheridan Street West and make a U-turn at SW 162nd Avenue to go east on Sheridan Street. Other alternate routes are Griffin Road and Pines Boulevard.
 - The ramp from westbound Sheridan Street to I-75 southbound may be closed Sunday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Motorists will be detoured to make a U-turn at SW 162nd Avenue and go east on Sheridan Street to enter I-75 southbound.
- **Segment E (North of Griffin Road to I-595)**
 - Two northbound lanes of I-75 north of Indian Trace will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.
 - Three southbound lanes of I-75 from north of Indian Trace to north of Royal Palm Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Friday between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - Two southbound lanes of the Sawgrass Expressway north of the I-595 interchange will be closed Sunday through Friday between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - Two eastbound lanes of I-595 just west of SW 136th Avenue will be closed Sunday through Friday between 7 p.m. and 4 a.m.
 - Two southbound lanes of I-75 at the I-595 interchange will be closed Sunday through Friday between 8 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.
 - Two northbound lanes of the Sawgrass Expressway at I-595 will be closed Sunday through Friday between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.

- One lane of the I-595 westbound ramp to southbound I-75 will be closed Sunday through Friday between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- All eastbound lanes of I-595 west of the Sawgrass Expressway will be closed Sunday through Friday between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. for bridge work. Motorists will be detoured to exit at Glades Parkway (Exit 22), go east on State Road 84 and use the Weston Road entrance to re-enter I-595 eastbound. **Please note, I-595 eastbound to the Sawgrass Expressway northbound will remain open during this closure.*
- All northbound lanes of the Sawgrass Expressway at I-595 will be closed Sunday through Friday between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. for bridge work. Motorists will be detoured to eastbound I-595 (Exit 19), exit at Flamingo Road (Exit 2), make a U-turn to go west on State Road 84, enter I-595 westbound and take the entrance ramp to the Sawgrass Expressway northbound (Exit 19).

Description: This 15-mile project will add four tolled managed lanes in the I-75 median from NW 170th Street in northern Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County. The work will be completed in four segments to minimize the impact to the public. This project includes entrance and exit access points to the express lanes; a bridge with a direct connection to 595 Express; integrated Intelligent Transportation System and tolling components; noise barrier walls at various locations and new signage, lighting, drainage and landscaping improvements. NORTHEAST BROWARD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

6. Bridges of the Isles and Sunrise Key Bridges Replacement in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- One lane of the Nurmi Drive Bridge, Fiesta Way Bridge, Royal Palm Drive Bridge, Isle of Venice Bridge and Sunrise Key Boulevard Bridge will be closed daily between 7 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. through Thursday, June 30. A flag crew will assist motorists through the work zone.
- One lane in each direction of Las Olas Boulevard from Royal Palm Drive to Isle of Venice Drive will be closed continuously through Thursday, June 30. There will be no construction-related lane closures during the following holidays and special events: Monday, July 4 for Independence Day Celebration.

Description: Project improvements include the demolition and replacement of the five low level bridges off Las Olas Boulevard to Royal Palm Drive, Nurmi Drive, Fiesta Way and Isle of Venice and the low level Sunrise Key Bridge off NE 6th Court. Cost/Completion: \$8 million. Completion in summer 2016.

7. Sunrise Boulevard Bridge over the Middle River

Traffic Impact:

- The sidewalk along the north side of the Sunrise Boulevard Middle River Bridge from NE 20th Avenue to Bayview Drive is closed through summer 2016. Pedestrians can use the sidewalk along the south side of the new bridge.
- One of the two left turn lanes from northbound Middle River Drive to westbound Sunrise Boulevard is closed through summer 2016.
- One westbound lane of Sunrise Boulevard from Middle River Drive to NE 20th Avenue is closed through summer 2016. Westbound traffic will travel in two lanes on the new bridge for the duration of the construction project.
- Left turns from westbound Sunrise Boulevard to southbound NE 20th Avenue are permitted from the left westbound lane throughout the duration of construction.
- The installation of a new fender system for the bridge will cause intermittent interruptions in the channel Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One lane in each direction of Sunrise Boulevard from NE 20th Avenue to east of Middle River Drive will be closed Monday through Wednesday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. for paving.

Description: Project improvements include replacing the replacing the Sunrise Boulevard Bridge over the Middle River, increasing the bridge clearance by approximately 4 feet, relocating utilities, installing new lighting, signalization, and pavement markings. 8. U.S. 1 Improvements from Broward Boulevard to NE 17th Way in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- All lanes are open through Friday, June 17.

Description: Project improvements include removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits, upgrading sidewalks and ramps to meet ADA requirements, repairing, adjusting, and replacing drainage structures throughout the project limits, upgrading the existing traffic signals to mast arm signals at the Sunrise Boulevard, NE 15th Avenue, NE 16th Terrace, and NE 17th Way intersections, installing a new signalized pedestrian crossing at NE 16th Terrace, upgrading all existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers, installing a video detection system at Broward Boulevard and US 1, upgrading signs and pavement markings throughout the project limits, including sharrows (share the road arrows) to the outside lane in each direction within the project limits, creating an Alternative Bike Route along local streets parallel to Sunrise Boulevard and through Holiday Park by adding sharrow pavement markings and signage along N Victoria Park Road, NE 11th Street, N Flagler Drive, NE 5th Avenue, NE 8th Street, G. Harold Martin Drive, NE 9th Street, NE 18th Avenue, NE 9th Place, and NE 20th Avenue. Cost/Completion: \$3.8 million. Completion in June 2016.

9. State Road A1A Improvements Project from Oakland Park Boulevard to Flamingo Avenue in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- Southbound A1A traffic from Oakland Park Boulevard to Flamingo Avenue is shifted to the west side of the road through summer 2016. Northbound A1A traffic

will remain on the east side of the road. Two lanes will remain open in each direction.

Description: Project improvements include removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits; upgrading sidewalks and ramps to meet ADA requirements; repairing, adjusting, and replacing drainage structures throughout the project limits; upgrading the following existing intersections to mast arm signals: 34th Street, mid-block between 36th and 40th Street, and at 40th Street; upgrading all existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers; upgrading signs and pavement markings throughout the project limits, including adding a 1.5 foot striped buffer to separate the four foot wide bike lanes from the outside vehicle travel lane; upgrading existing lighting along the corridor to lighting with a variable intensity function that can be accessed remotely in order to cause minimal disruption to sea turtles during their nesting season; adding elevated roadway lighting and lower level lighting to illuminate the sidewalk, and adding a business access drive aisle along the east side of road between NE 34th and NE 36th Street. Cost/Completion: \$9.3 million. Completion in summer 2017.

10. A1A from SE 3rd Street to NE 7th Street in Deerfield Beach

Traffic Impact:

- One lane of A1A from Hillsboro Boulevard to NE 7th Street may be closed Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. for sidewalk construction, shoulder widening and drainage improvements. A flag crew will assist motorists through the work zone.
- One lane of A1A from SE 3rd Street to NE 2nd Street may be closed Monday through Friday between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. for Florida Power and Light utility pole improvements. A flag crew will assist motorists through the work zone.

Description: Project improvements include removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits, widening the roadway along A1A to accommodate five foot bike lanes, upgrading drainage within the project limits, upgrading sidewalks and ramps to meet ADA requirements, upgrading existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers at Hillsboro Blvd and upgrading signs and pavement markings throughout the project limits. Cost/Completion: \$1.7 million. Completion in summer 2016.

11. Hillsboro Boulevard Bridge over the Intracoastal Waterway Improvements Project in Deerfield Beach

Traffic Impact:

- The outside lane in either direction of the bridge will be closed Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. for bike plate installation and replacement of the sidewalk walking surface.
- The sidewalk on either side of the bridge will be closed Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. for the replacement of the metal walking surface. Pedestrians will be directed to the side of the bridge with the open sidewalk.

Description: The improvements under this project consist of adding new bicycle friendly riding surface plates to the outside lane of the bridge in each direction, replacing the aluminum textured

sidewalk plates on both sides of the bridge to provide an improved walking surface, improving existing maintenance hatches and platforms on the bridge and improving the existing span locks. 12. A1A Improvements Project from East of the Mercedes River Bridge to Sunrise Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of A1A from east of the Mercedes River to Alhambra Street will be closed Monday through Friday between 6 a.m. and 4 p.m. for improvements to railing at the Mercedes River Bridge, widening near Mayan Drive, concrete removal, curb and gutter installation, and sidewalk construction.
- One lane in each direction of Sunrise Boulevard from the Intracoastal Waterway bridge to A1A will be closed Monday through Friday between 6 a.m. and 4 p.m. for concrete removal, curb and gutter installation and drainage work.

Description: The improvements under this project consist of removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits, upgrading sidewalks and ramps to meet ADA requirements, upgrading all existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers, upgrading signs and pavement markings throughout the project limits, widening Sunrise Boulevard to accommodate four-foot wide bike lanes in each direction, modifying pavement striping and markings to provide shared use or dedicated bike lanes on A1A, and adding in-roadway lighting at several crosswalks. 13. A1A Landscaping from Sunrise Boulevard to NE 18th Street in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in either direction may be closed intermittently Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Description: The improvements under this contract include installation of an irrigation system and planting of landscaping in the newly constructed medians and at various locations along the eastside promenade.

Cost/Completion: \$685,307. Completion is fall 2016.

NORTHWEST BROWARD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

14. CSX Bridge Replacement over the South Fork of the New River in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- The outside shoulder of the eastbound I-595 exit ramp to northbound I-95 is closed through early 2017.
- There will be intermittent interruptions in the channel for marine traffic while contractor performs some activities with the bridge in the lowered position. The bridge will open when a vessel approaches, but there may be short delays.

- The New River Channel will be closed to marine traffic Monday through Friday between 9:30 p.m. and 6 a.m. through Wednesday, June 29. The contractor will be performing railroad installation work on the movable span with the bridge in the lowered position.

Description: Project improvements include replacing the existing South Florida Rail Corridor CSX Railroad rolling lift bridge just west of I-95 over the south fork of the New River in Fort Lauderdale. 15. Andrews Avenue Reconstruction / Realignment Project in Pompano Beach

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of Andrews Avenue from Atlantic Boulevard to SW 3 Street / John Knox Boulevard will be closed intermittently Wednesday, June 15 through Friday, July 1 between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. for final paving and pavement markings.
