

**YOUTH EDUCATION AND SAFETY
ADVISORY BOARD
NOVEMBER 29, 2010**

1. ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at 6:07 pm. Board members present were Chair John Pisula, Vice-Chair Lorraine Hofheinz, Marcy Fallahzadeh, Stacy Shaffer and Barbara Ann Tilley. Also present was Assistant Town Clerk Evelyn Roig recording the meeting. Hal Axler, Tim Curtin, Nan Gault and Diana Podel were absent.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 Review of Grants

Chair Pisula stated that the grants had been approved previously but there were some questions and clarification was needed before the teachers were contacted. Ms. Shaffer provided an update regarding the application submitted by Suzanne Aceto of Indian Ridge Middle School and the hygiene issue involving the towels. She indicated that Ms. Aceto stated that the towels would not be issued to all the students but to have them on hand if a student showed signs of heat illness the towel would be placed around that students' neck allowing the body temperature to cool more quickly. There was laundry equipment at the school which was accessible and the towels could be laundered and made available.

Ms. Tilley made a motion, seconded by Vice-Chair Hofheinz, to approve the application submitted by Ms. Aceto. In a voice vote, with Al Haxler, Tim Curtin, Nan Gault and Diana Podel being absent, all voted in favor. **(Motion carried 5-0)**

The application submitted by Nancy Boulger of Western High School was reviewed. Chair Pisula stating that her spoke with Ms. Boulger who indicated to him the equipment would not be kept by the student. The equipment would be assigned to the student; however, when they graduated from high school, if they moved out of the area, the equipment would have to be returned. Ms. Boulger would be trained by the Davie Fire Department and the students would be part of the Town's CERT Program.

Chair Pisula added that the students were high school seniors and were expected to be highly motivated. He stated that Ms. Boulger was a Health Science Teacher.

Vice-Chair Hofheinz made a motion, seconded by Ms. Fallahzadeh to approve the application by Ms. Boulger. In a voice vote, with Hal Axler, Tim Curtin, Nan Gault and Diana Podel being absent, all voted in favor. **(Motion carried 5-0)**

There being no objections and no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 6:16 p.m.
