

**DECLARATION OF
EMERGENCY REGULATIONS
ORDER #20-04**

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, pursuant to Resolution 2020-080, the Town of Davie declared a State of Emergency;

WHEREAS, the Town Council and Mayor authorized the Town Administrator to exercise emergency powers to mitigate the effects of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, Broward County issued Emergency Order 20-08 on April 28, 2020 which is part of a coordinated effort with Monroe, Miami-Dade, and Palm Beach counties to reopen certain parks, golf courses, and other recreational facilities to provide the community with opportunities to exercise and obtain other health benefits during the continuing crisis; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Davie seeks to provide continuity and consistency for its residents, visitors, and businesses across the Town and throughout Broward County by amending its existing Declaration of Emergency Regulations to follow and participate in the coordinated phased reopening of non-essential businesses in the same manner as Broward County without further action by the Town Administrator.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard J. Lemack, Town Administrator of the Town of Davie, Florida, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Florida and the Town of Davie, promulgate the following Executive Order to take immediate effect:

1. This Emergency Regulation hereby amends the following Town Declarations to automatically conform to the provisions and timing of Broward County's Emergency Orders pertaining to the coordinated phased reopening of non-essential businesses in relation to the COVID-19 Pandemic without further action of the Town Administrator. Specifically, it applies to the following orders:
 - a. Town of Davie Declaration of Emergency Regulation 20-01; and
 - b. Town of Davie Declaration of Emergency Regulation 20-02; and
 - c. Town of Davie Declaration of Emergency Regulation 20-03.
2. The Town of Davie shall follow Broward County's Emergency Orders pertaining to the coordinated phased reopening of non-essential businesses in relation to the COVID-19 Pandemic and any inconsistent or conflicting provisions between a Town of Davie Emergency Regulation and Broward County Emergency Regulation, the conflicting or inconsistent provision in the Town of Davie Emergency Regulation shall be repealed to the extent to conform with the Broward County Emergency Regulation.

3. The Town of Davie Parks, attached in Exhibit "A", shall reopen no earlier than Sunday, May 10, 2020, subject to either a downward trajectory of documented cases within a 14-day period or a downward trajectory of positive tests as a percent of total tests within a 14-day period as of April 23, 2020.

4. Use of the parks shall be governed by the minimum requirements set forth in Broward County Emergency order 20-08, and as amended.

5. The Town reserves the right to open and close parks and park amenities as needed and without having to issue a new Emergency Order.

6. This Emergency Order supersedes any contrary provisions in any prior Town of Davie Emergency Order. Except as superseded, all Town of Davie Emergency Orders remain in full force and effect.

7. This Declaration of Emergency Regulations may be enforced by Town law and code enforcement pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, and other applicable state, county, and Town laws, rules, and regulations. Alternatively, and in addition to enforcement by law enforcement personnel, the Town may enforce its Emergency Regulations through Code Enforcement Special Magistrate proceedings by issuance of Notices of Violations pursuant to the Town Code of Ordinances.

8. This emergency order may be amended as necessary by the Town Administrator.

9. This Emergency Regulation shall take effect immediately and shall expire upon the expiration of the existing state of local emergency, unless earlier terminated by the Town.


