

RESOLUTION NO. R-2010-148

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A SCHEDULE OF TREE MITIGATION VALUES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town has adopted tree preservation requirements into the Town Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the tree preservation requirements provide that, where trees must be removed and cannot reasonably be relocated or replaced, that the landowner may mitigate the loss of trees on a parcel by making a "payment in lieu" into a tree preservation fund, which funds may be used by the Town for landscape improvements throughout the Town; and

WHEREAS, the schedule of tree mitigation values was originally adopted into the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires adopt the schedule of tree mitigation values by resolution instead of by ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA.

SECTION 1. The schedule of tree mitigation values is hereby adopted as set forth in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect on upon adoption.

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A SCHEDULE OF TREE MITIGATION VALUES FOR CERTAIN SINGLE- FAMILY LOTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Davie has adopted tree preservation regulations consistent with Broward County regulations;

WHEREAS, the Town's tree preservation regulations provide that, where trees are removed and cannot reasonably be relocated or replaced, the landowner may mitigate the loss of trees on a parcel by making a "payment in lieu" into a tree preservation fund, which funds may then be used by the Town for landscape improvements throughout the Town ;

WHEREAS, the Town adopted a schedule of tree mitigation values by Resolution 2010-148; and

WHEREAS, a separate resolution is needed to adopt mitigation values for certain single-family residential lots, as referenced in Section 12-154.1 of the Town Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA:


SECTION 1. The schedule of mitigation values provided in the attached Exhibit "A" is hereby adopted.

**EXHIBIT "A"**

**Tree Mitigation Values  
For Certain Single-Family Lots Pursuant to Sec. 12-154.1, Town Code**

<b>Tree/palm to be removed</b>	<b>Mitigation value</b>
Palm, any size	\$100 per palm
Tree 10 inches or less DBH	\$150 per tree
Tree more than 10 inches DBH	\$300 per tree

DBH: Diameter at breast height
