SR 93/I-75 IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM SR 822/SHERIDAN STREET TO SR 818/GRIFFIN ROAD

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming SR 93/I-75 Improvements Project, from SR 822/Sheridan Street to SR 818/Griffin Road, in the Town of Davie, Town of Southwest Ranches, City of Pembroke Pines, and Cooper City. Construction Cost: \$12.7 million Construction Start: April 2023 Estimated Completion: Spring 2025

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Roadway widening to provide continuous auxiliary lanes and 10-foot shoulders in each direction of SR 93/I-75
- Repaving and restriping along SR 93/I-75
- Replacing overhead signage
- Installing new guardrail
- Updating drainage, lighting and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS)

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures on SR 93/I-75 are permitted nightly, as needed, 8:30 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. To ensure motorist safety, access to the Managed Lanes may be restricted during these closures.
- Full closures of the SR 93/I-75 entrance and exit ramps are permitted nightly, 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.


