2. ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m. Roll was called, and it was determined a quorum was present.

Mr. Pezoldt reported the helmets given out at the last Bicycle Safety Event were donated by Amscot. He has contacted a local Amscot branch and was given a contact. We are currently awaiting their response.

Chair Curtain brought up the idea of raffling off a bike. Discussion ensued regarding the use of sponsors, including Rick Case Honda, Walmart, or a local bike dealer.

5.2 Water Safety Poster Contest

Mr. Pezoldt provided the Committee with a handout with the information for this year's contest. The guidelines would be sent to the schools in February. The posters will be due in the beginning of April and judging to take place at the next meeting. Winners would be invited to the May 3, 2023 Town Council meeting. Chair Curtain suggested awarding the same prizes as last year's contest. The Committee then discussed a theme for the poster contest and "Swim Smart" was ultimately chosen as for this year's theme.

Ms. Chaykin made a ***motion*** to choose "Swim Smart" as the theme for the Town of Davie's 2023 Water Safety Poster Contest. Mr. Lasaga seconded the motion. In a voice vote, the motion passed unanimously.
