

**TOWN OF DAVIE
TOWN COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
JUNE 14, 2016**

I. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The meeting was called to order at 3:32 p.m. and was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. ROLL CALL

Present at the meeting were Mayor Paul, Vice-Mayor Luis and Councilmembers Caletka (by phone), Hattan and Starkey. Also present were Town Administrator Lemack, Assistant Town Administrator Lewis, Attorney Allan Weinthal and Town Clerk Roig recording the meeting.

III. RECONSIDERATION OF TEMPORARY USE PERMITS

Vice-Mayor Luis made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Starkey, to reconsider Council's previous vote on the Temporary Use Permit for TU 16-112, Harvest Fellowship. In a voice vote, all voted in favor. (Motion carried 5-0)

Vice-Mayor Luis made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Hattan to reconsider Council's previous vote on the Temporary Use Permit for TU 16-109, Fireworks Lady & Co. In a voice vote, all voted in favor. (Motion carried 5-0)

1. TU 16-112, Harvest Fellowship, 6770 Stirling Road (B-2)

Vice-Mayor Luis made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Hattan to approve. In a voice vote, all voted in favor. (Motion carried 5-0)

2. TU 16-109, Fireworks Lady & Co., 13200 State Road 84 (B-2)

Vice-Mayor Luis made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Hattan to approve. In a voice vote, all voted in favor. (Motion carried 5-0)

Mayor Paul asked Mr. Lemack and Mr. Rayson to research action Council could take to limit fireworks sales in the future. Mr. Weinthal agreed the City Attorney's office would look into this.

Councilmember Starkey had spoken with Mr. Weinthal about laws regarding the use of illegal fireworks and enforcement. She noted this problem had existed for some time in the Town and enforcement must play a big role. Mayor Paul was especially concerned about the danger of sparklers.
