REGULAR MEETING

June 13, 2018

6:30 p.m.

I. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. and was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. ROLL CALL

Present at the meeting were Mayor Paul, Vice Mayor Caletka and Councilmembers Hattan, Luis and Starkey. Also present were Town Administrator Lemack, Deputy Town Administrator Lewis, Assistant Town Administrator Holste, Town Attorney Rayson and Town Clerk Roig recording the meeting.

Mayor Paul requested a moment of silence in honor of Shizuka Matsuki, who had just passed away.

III. OPEN PUBLIC MEETING

Davie resident Maureen Savory spoke regarding Park City Mobile Home Community. She stated that the work construction on Pine Island Road has caused cars to use their neighborhood as the pass through to get to State Road 84 and 595. She stated that the cars are speeding through the community at 50-60 mph, early in the morning and in the evening. On behalf of her community, she requested the police monitoring in the morning and in the evening between the hours 7 and 9. She also requested a speed table in order to slowdown the vehicles and for the current two way stop to be changed into a four way stop at SW 18th Street and SW 86 Avenue. Mayor Paul asked Major Engle from the police department to speak with her. She further explained to Ms. Savory that a three way stop is not permitted to be used as a traffic calming device, however, she asked that the Town Engineer speak to Broward County staff to determine if it was warranted.

Jeff Pohlman, Assistant Director, Recreation and Cultural Arts, provided a presentation on the Fourth of July event. Activities for the children included; fun and games at the pool, bounce house, and a petting zoo. He also stated there would be an adult games zone. Mr. Pohlman stated that they made a major change this year to the layout which provided additional parking lot spaces inside the park.

Major Dale Engle advised that the Police Department has initiated officer training to better understand the statutes regarding fireworks. He also stated that the Police Department would be educating the public by providing safety information through social media.

2. 2018 Public Affairs Academy Recognition, C. Mitch Taylor, Intergovernmental Affairs Manager

Mr. Taylor provided an overview of the program. Mayor Paul recognized Brandon Stewart and Anyaa Sorenson who were presented with certificates.

XIII. MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBER COMMENTS

COUNCILMEMBER HATTAN

No comments.

COUNCILMEMBER STARKEY

Thanked Council for the birthday wishes.

VICE MAYOR CALETKA

COUNTY SURTAX Vice Mayor Caletka advised that Broward County had proposed to put two rail lines through Davie, having four all together. One of the rail lines would be in the industrial area down 441. Vice Mayor Caletka advised that he told the County that the Town was against that corridor as well as the rail coming from the north onto University going down to the Davie campus. Vice Mayor Caletka advised the county that the Town was only in favor when it was part of the loop that went around the university, Nova Drive, Griffin Road and the airport.

MANAGERS Vice Mayor Caletka advised that managers would be called for a special meeting which will request cities to start to educate the public regarding the sales tax. They will also ask each municipality to allocate funds to provide education to the communities.

DRAFT TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PLAN Vice Mayor Caletka advised there were eight projects listed for the Town of Davie. One project was bringing back funding for the Park and Ride on Griffin and I-75 which the MPO had previously turned down. Another project listed was the Eastside Ramp improvements at Griffin Road. He advised that he made contact with secretary O'Reily who advised the first project would be removed from the list. Vice Mayor Caletka then advised that the second project was in violation with the agreement with FDOT. A meeting was held between Vice Mayor Caletka and Southwest Ranches, who opposed to the project in Tallahassee where it was agreed that a study would be funded for the intersection and a no build action would be imposed. Vice Mayor Caletka planed on removing the project at the next MPO meeting. Council agreed.

METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION ADVISORY COUNCIL Vice Mayor Caletka announced that he was voted as the vice chair of the state MPO. He stated that he received a unanimous vote for the E-Pass and Sunpass item that allowed disabled veterans free use of Florida Sunpass tollways and parking facilities.

NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REGIONAL COUNCIL

Vice Mayor Caletka announced that he was reelected to the National Association of Regional Council (NARC).

COUNCILMEMBER LUIS

THANK YOU Councilmember Luis advised that over the weekend he had fire in his home. He thanked the Fire Department for their quick response and advised the public about the importance of smoke detectors in their homes.

MAYOR PAUL

FIRE DEPARTMENT Mayor Paul advised that she has received a letter from Mrs. Hassan from Imagination Farms thanking the Fire Department for rescuing ducks that fell in the storm drain.

DAVID FLAHERTY Mayor Paul announced Mr. Flaherty's retirement and wished him good luck.

HISPANIC VOTE Mayor Paul advised that the Town would be teaming up with the Hispanic Vote group. A family event will be held at Potter's Park on July 14th where the Broward County Supervisor of Elections will be offering voter registration services.

HULL HOUSE BOOK Mayor Paul stated that she had received a book about the six remarkable Hull House women. She stated that her great great aunt, Lillian Wald, founded the Henry Street Settlement and was mentioned in the book.

TREE REMOVAL Mayor Paul advised that she had received a letter from a resident which she gave to Mr. Lemack regarding the removal of trees at the side of Nob Hill, south of Ridge Place.

MILITARY APPRECIATION DAY Mayor Paul advised that Military Appreciation Day was Saturday June 23, 2018.

LEADERSHIP FORUM Mayor Paul stated that she attended the Broward Leaders Roundtable on climate and resilience at the Long Key Nature Center in May where she obtained a copy of the Climate Action Plan which was a local strategy to address local climate change.

BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB Mayor Paul stated that the Boys and Girls Club was interested in having the Town help them obtain SROs. She advised that the topic would be discussed with Mr. Lemack.
