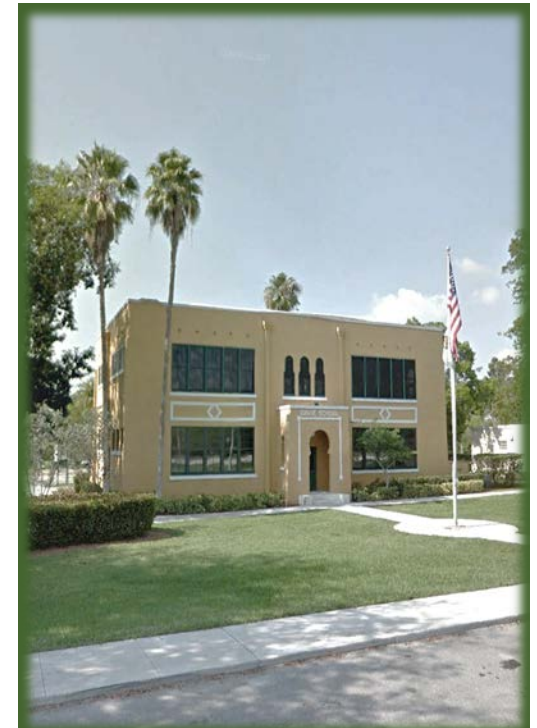

## Historic Preservation Board

## Board Membership (Sec. 12-74.11(b)(c))

- The board members shall be residents of the Town.
- The board shall be comprised of five (5) members.
- The term for a seat on the board shall be four (4) years.
- The board shall be professionals from the following disciplines<sup>1</sup>:
  1. Architecture
  2. History
  3. Architecture History
  4. Planning
  5. Prehistoric/Historic Archaeology
  6. Folklore
  7. Cultural Anthropology
  8. Curation
  9. Conservation
  10. Landscape Architecture

<sup>1</sup> In the event no qualified individual has expressed interest in serving in a specific category, the Council may nominate an individual with demonstrated special interest, experience, or knowledge in history, architecture, or related disciplines to make up the balance of the membership

## Board Tasks (Sec. 12-74.11(g))

- Review proposed certificate of appropriateness (COA) and certificate to dig (CTD) applications.
- Recommend historical markers, plaques, and other recognition for individual historic resources, districts, archaeological sites, archaeological zones, and paleontological zones.
- Develop and apply design guidelines.
- Initiate, review, and update historic site surveys in the Town.
- Review National Register nominations and provide comments to the appropriate entities.
- Recommend certain grants and financial incentives that assist in promoting preservation.
- Promote the awareness of preservation and its community benefits.
- Fulfill all obligations and requirements associated with the Certified Local Government (CLG) Program.
