1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Present at the meeting were Chair Paul, Vice Chair Luis, Board Members Hattan and Starkey. Also present were CRA Executive Director/Town Administrator Lemack, CRA Director Holste, CRA Attorney Rayson, CRA Program Manager Ellett and Board Secretary Brewster recording the minutes.

Chair Paul asked for a motion to excuse Board Member Caletka. Vice Chair Luis, made a motion, seconded by Board Member Starkey to excuse Board Member Caletka. In a voice vote, all voted in favor. (Motion carried 4-0)

3. PRESENTATION – CRA MID-YEAR BUDGET REVIEW, WILLIAM ACKERMAN, BUDGET AND FINANCE DIRECTOR

Mr. Ackerman, Budget and Finance Director presented a power point presentation regarding the CRA's financial activity from October 1, 2019 through March 31, 2019. A copy of the presentation is attached hereto.

Mr. Ackerman mentioned the reason he was making the presentation to the CRA Board is for transparency. Mr. Ackerman provided a brief overview of the CRA expenditures which included a revenue snapshot of funds received, expenditures, personnel services, operating, capital outlay, debt service as well as grants and aids. He also provided information regarding fund balances including the CRA Reserve Fund which included the 2010 Bond Issuance. Mr. Ackerman mentioned the CRA only has approximately \$1.1 million in bond funding left due to the magnitude of projects which the CRA has undertaken. He indicated by the end of the fiscal year, there should be no bond money remaining and moving forward, staff will continue to review the monthly financial statements and will provide updates to the CIP and budget for next year.
